Aims and contents	
	<p>Winter term, 1st semester</p> <p>During the first semester, the students of the various universities are to reach a comparable level of knowledge in order to allow international cooperation and joint studies as soon as possible.</p>
10	<p>Basic module B1 (common module: E-Learning, ca. 4 semester periods per week): Basics of lexicography: usage, dictionary, lexicographical entries, typology of dictionaries, lexicography and culture, theory and practice.</p>
10	<p>Basic module B2 (home module): A lexicographically-oriented module (approx. 4 semester periods per week) with university teachers participating in the master programme.</p>
	<p>Soft skills modules B3 (home module):</p>
5	<p>B3a course of English (elective course: 4-6 semester periods per week)</p>
5	<p>B3b course of German (elective course: 4-6 semester periods per week)</p>
5	<p>B3c computer science (elective course)</p>
5	<p>B3d languages (elective course: Hungarian, Portuguese, Spanish, French, Italian, Polish, etc.)</p>
	<p>From section B3a to B3c/d 5 ECTS are obligatory, 15 ECTS are possible, 10 ECTS can be credited.</p>
25-30	<p>During the first semester all students should have acquired 25-30 ECTS points. Those who have acquired only 25 ECTS points (i.e. students with a BA in German and English) have to acquire 35 ECTS in the second semester.</p>
	<p>Summer term, 2nd semester</p> <p>The second semester provides an overview of the whole range of lexicography. Every university offers special knowledge. All courses will be taken at one of the participating universities. The local organisers change every year.</p>
5 each	<p>Advanced modules 1 to 10: 10 modules as block seminars or continuous courses with 2 semester hours. All students are required to travel. The teachers of the partner universities hold the block seminars, the local teacher holds his or her seminar throughout the semester. The students have to acquire 30 (35) ECTS, may, however, acquire more (maximum 45 ECTS), organisation plan according to special announcement.</p> <p>A1: Metalexicography A2: History of lexicography A3: Modeling and representing data in digital lexicography A4: Research into dictionary use A5: Special field lexicography and terminology A6: Computational lexicography A7: Dictionaries and translation A8: Lexicography and lexicology A9: Dictionary planning and production A10: Learner lexicography</p> <p>Σ 30</p>

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Aims and contents	
	All students have to have 60 ECTS points after the first year.
	Winter term, 3rd semester The third semester is dedicated to specialisation as well as to application of the knowledge acquired in the second semester; at the same time the master thesis is prepared. The contents depend on the respective universities.
10	In-depth module 1: Series of lectures by the teachers of the different universities via video. The students have to evaluate the lectures and write a review on a dictionary.
10	In-depth module 2 (home module): Special topic (depending on the seminars offered at the home university). Here special requirements are possible.
10	In-depth module 3: Internship (home module): A four to six-week-internship at a publisher or a company or a research institute (during the semester break or during the semester).

	Summer term, 4th semester

In the second semester, one university will be the centre of studies for all students. Therefore, the number of participants is limited; travel is financed via Erasmus or similar programs. The teachers of the partner universities stay for 7 to 10 days; travel is financed via Erasmus or similar programs. A block seminar lasts from Monday to Friday. For information about the exams see separate organisation plan.

The in-depth module 1 will be done with the help of online lectures or integrate current lectures on campus.

Notes on the 4th semester

The ECTS points for the master thesis granted according to the individual university regulations will open up further possibilities (accompanying seminars, etc.).
